Old Business:				
Credentialing	Melody/Stacy Jones	Get with Stacy about scheduling time with the verifiers for your department to complete the verifier course ASAP.	Melody has 2 versions of the AEMT exam completed and will be working on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> version. She will also be working on the 3 versions of the EMT exam.  She will be reaching out shortly for departments that would be interested in piloting these exams in EMSTesting.  If you haven't gotten with Stacy about your department going through the verifier course, please email or call him to get this scheduled. He's working on different methods to accomplish this. It can be via zoom or in person for now. Working on a possible Moodle option as well.  Jacobsen is working on a credentialing video that will be available for the EMS System to consume.  Reminder for departments to start thinking about how/who will be tracking the provider progress within their individual dept's. iAuditor videos are being worked on and we will be showing some of the analytics in terms of how to track provider progress with skills check-offs.

Work group is needing MDLC support and enforcement as far as agreed upon common platform.

Next step will be another work group meeting to finalize inventory, buying bags, and hopefully can implement by plan by January 2021.

Question asked about if a pilot was still going to be taking place. Another suggestion to have guidelines about changing inventory/bags, etc. Discussion around any inventory changes should come through MDLC before being changed and should probably need to be reviewed annually through this group.

Discussion around modules and the cost associated with the modules and if departments were all going to be purchasing these modules. MED-ACT has a blue kit and will continue to use them. So, there will be a variation of the "modules" throughout the system to begin with. The thought was that maybe through attrition we could all get the same modules eventually.

Pulled around 25-30 STEMI calls and reviewed them to pinpoint common trends.  We will be working on education points, as well as guidance on how to review these calls from an ALS and a BLS viewpoint.	

KangooFix Neonatal Restraint Device	Dr. Jacobsen	We will be declining this as an option for our system. In reviewing the study around this device, the EMS providers had negative feedback on being able to assess the baby while in this device.  We will be encouraging separate transport for the baby.  We do think there is potential benefit in looking at how we keep the baby warm during transport, and we will continue to investigate this.
Pediatric BVM	Brian Schoenig	Pediatric BVM's are still in short supply. The vendor is hoping shipments will catch up in Sept.
Sleep Study	Dr. Jacobsen	Enrollment will start on Aug. 1st. Please pass info along to your departments if providers are interested in your departments. This is an important topic in EMS and if you can fwd the link again to your individual departments that would be appreciated as we do not have direct emails for all the providers in the system.
